Kosme UK’s dedicated servicing team carry a wide range of spare parts with them in their vehicle, so the vast majority of needs can met as soon as the engineer arrives. Because they work closely with their engineering colleagues

in Italy, Kosme UK's team all have extensive training and experience of the machines they work on and access to the very latest diagnostic and fault-finding equipment and software.

“Our team of engineers are also specifically trained to work in the unique conditions of a food production area,” adds Richard Portman. “We have used a specialist consultancy to advise and enforce the strict Health and Safety legislation involved with the sites our engineers visit as the maintenance of cleanliness is vital. This also means that all our engineers are qualified to work on the entire Kosme range, so there are no issues with getting specific experts to a particular site.”

As well as the team of mobile engineers, Kosme UK utilises the latest in mobile computing and smartphones to relay information back to the UK Head Office, or if required, directly to the Italian Head Office for analysis or advice. “We can detect most faults remotely and often these can be resolved at the same time. With any software it is often possible to perform firmware upgrades or patches to rectify or reprogram Kosme machines onsite. We have full access to the engineering teams who develop and build the machines so finding a solution is assured.”
